Instructions for joining the Conference Dinner.

Please arrive at the Eiffel Tower 60 minutes before your reservation time, i.e., 17:30, to allow enough time to pass through the security check, collect your elevator ticket at the Reception, and take the elevator.

HOW TO ACCESS THE ESPLANADE?

At the foot of the Eiffel Tower, please go to Entrance 1 (Allée des Refuzniks) with your reservation confirmation and join the queue dedicated to the Brasserie. This queue will be clearly identified with specific signage. For security reasons, bags will be subject to inspection.

COLLECT YOUR ELEVATOR TICKET

To reach the first floor, you must first go to the Madame Brasserie reception desk, located on the esplanade, to collect your elevator ticket. Don't forget: by scanning the QR code displayed at the reception, you can take part in our Mystery Game, a treasure hunt that will accompany you all the way to your arrival at Madame Brasserie.
